
BRINGING THE OUTSIDE IN

WELCOME TO YOUR HEALING RETREAT

AT CORTELLUCCI VAUGHAN HOSPITAL, ALL ENTRANCES LEAD TO PROMENADE MAIN STREET

t begins as soon as you open the doors to Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital.
Light, warmth and community characterize the main floor welcome area of the hospital, punctuated by a showpiece fireplace and reception desk, a Promenade Main Street and view of the dining atrium below.



Stepping inside the main entrance, visitors are drawn to the lobby's architectural showpiece — a two-storey, double-sided fireplace extending from the ground floor to the dining atrium below. Glazed railings next to the fireplace and overlooking the atrium lead the way to the Vic de Zen Family Welcome Centre, open seven days a week.



Just past the reception desk, the hospital's main west-east corridor — dubbed Promenade Main Street — offers ready access to patient registration and the main elevators. Designed for ease and efficiency, the registration area features a series of self-service kiosks.

The library, spiritual care, pharmacy, retail shops and food services are located further west on Promenade Main Street. A second fireplace overlooks a beautiful cascading garden wall in the Spiritual Care Courtyard.



One level below, visitors travel through a serene indoor corridor from the parking arcade to the hospital, where they are greeted by another reception area and the lower level of the Christopher and Franca Zeppa & Family Cascading Garden Link.



The eastern wing of Promenade Main Street connects the main entrance to the Giovanni and Anna De Gasperis • Eugene and Eva Kohn Learning Centre, one of the first and most comprehensive learning and conference centres within a Canadian hospital, where clinicians, students and staff can practice new skills and link to experts beyond the hospital walls.

THE HEALING POWER OF LIGHT AND GARDEN

SIX OUTDOOR COURTYARDS PROMOTE HEALING AND WELL-BEING

nspired by research that shows the positive link between patient outcomes and natural light and views, Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital includes six outdoor courtyards to promote healing and well-being among patients and visitors alike. These spaces also benefit staff, giving them a much-needed break from their clinical space during a long 10-hour shift. Each features lush gardens, seating areas, functional and feature lighting, security cameras and a hydronic snow melt system to support year-round use.



The main courtyard, adjacent to the dining area on the lower level and stretching two storeys to the hospital's main entrance, is lush with greenery and features plenty of benches, chairs and umbrella tables for respite and socialization.

Designed to also accommodate special events, it includes visual and audio

presentation technologies.





A meditation labyrinth and cascading garden dominate the Spiritual Care Courtyard next to the non-denominational chapel on Promenade Main Street. The lower level of the garden, called the Christopher and Franca Zeppa & Family Cascading Garden Link, is visible to visitors entering the hospital from the ground level parking garage and from Promenade Main Street. The Spiritual Care Courtyard is also available for private services and receptions.

Spiritual Care Courtyard



The auditorium, classrooms and laboratories in the Giovanni and Anna De Gasperis • Eugene and Eva Kohn Learning Centre are clustered around a large glass-walled outdoor courtyard that brings natural light into the surrounding corridors and offers learners space for rest and reflection.



Two private rooftop courtyards within the fifth-floor Mental Health Unit and another within the Critical Care Unit on the second floor are specially designed to accommodate the health, privacy and safety needs of patients and their families with accessible entrances and direct sightlines to nursing stations.

LIGHTING THE WAY

When windows weren't an option for the Lorenzo and Melina De Meneghi Boulevard of Care connecting the Magna Emergency to the medical imaging department in the interior of the hospital, Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital found a creative solution. A large skylight extending over the boulevard guides patients and staff along their care journey, providing a visual connection with nature and a ray of hope during what is often a very anxious and stressful time.

Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital transforms those expectations by reimagining a traditional public space and adding another not commonly seen in a health care setting.

A PARTNERSHIP FIRST WITH VAUGHAN PUBLIC LIBRARY

At Mackenzie Health, learning is at the heart of our commitment to our patients, our staff and our community, which is why we've introduced a fully-functioning branch of the Vaughan Public Library on the Promenade Main Street of Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital.

The 4,000-square-foot facility is both a community resource and a hub for research, education and the enrichment of our patients and their families, clinicians, staff and students. It features the same access to books, resources and programming available at every Vaughan Public Library branch, including electronic databases on wide-ranging subjects including health and medicine.

The Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital branch also features multiple meeting rooms for research, study and consultation. Bright and spacious with glazed glass walls, it offers an ideal blend of privacy, light and accessibility to the nearby retail shops, food services, pharmacy and spiritual care centre and courtyard.

REIMAGINING THE HOSPITAL CAFETERIA

One of the busiest public spaces in any hospital is the cafeteria. It's often also one of the most overlooked opportunities for building community and promoting health and well-being. At Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital, we have transformed the traditional hospital cafeteria into a bright and spacious, two-storey, indoor/outdoor atrium, where patients and visitors can take time to refresh and connect.

Located on the hospital's lower level, but open to the main floor entrance, the atrium is one of the most prominent and architecturally significant public spaces within the new hospital. Visitors to the reception desk and Vic de Zen Family Welcome Centre are able to gaze over the railings into the space, which is anchored at its centre by a two-storey multi-faced fireplace stretching up to the main floor.




